One in 5 respondents prefer to live in an attached home in a walkable community versus living in a detached home in a conventional neighborhood.



### Increased Quality of Life

88% who agree that there are places to walk to nearby also report that they are more staisfied with their quality of life.

More than 70% of residents said that walkability, a short commute and proximity to highways are important when deciding where to live.



#### Transportation
