Glossary:

Vacant: The Member of Congress (MOC) does **not** have an assigned FPC, or the MOC seat is vacant.

Submitted: Any FPC/MOC pair that has been nominated by the state, but is waiting to be approved by NAR.

Approved: Any FPC/MOC pair that has been approved by NAR

Handy Hint

Most FPC/MOC pairs have already been approved by NAR for the 118th Congress. The "Submitted" counter is most helpful during the nomination process after each election (every 2 years)

To nominate a member to be an FPC for a Member of Congress:

1. Click the PLUS icon between the Member of Congress and FPC cards.
2. Enter the 9-digit Member ID of the member you wish to nominate.
3. Add your nomination in the nomination description field
 - If the member you selected has been an FPC in the past, their past nomination will appear. You can update this information or leave it as is.

When complete, click **SUBMIT**, and NAR will receive a notification to review the nomination.

A **yellow** link will appear between the nominated FPC and MOC, and the “submitted” counter at the top of the page will increase.

Once approved by NAR, the link will turn **green** and the “approved” counter will increase.
